TRANSITS IN EXCESS OF TWELVE (12) HOURS

The Board of Commissioners of Pilots of the State of New York (Board)

received a request from Block Island Pilots to require two pilots on all transits of

Long Island Sound/Block Island Sound in excess of 12 hours due to the potential

of pilot fatigue.

The Board has reviewed the request and agrees that a single pilot on

transits over 12 hours can present an unsafe situation.

Therefore, the Board authorizes Block Island Pilots to implement a Policy

and Procedure requiring two pilots on all transits in excess of 12 hours on the

Long Island Sound. Pilots should be changed as nearly as practical at mid-point

in the transit. It is understood that two full pilot fees will be assessed based upon

the current Association tariff, as well as a fee for launch hire, however, the fee for

a pilot in excess of 8 hours will be waived.
