POLICY AND PROCEDURE MEMORANDUM No. 11105

TO: New York and Connecticut State Dual Licensed Long Island-Block Island Sound Pilots Operating Under Authority of Their New York State Pilot Licenses.

REF: CT/NY Memorandum of Understanding ("CT/NY MOA") dated 8 February 2000 (copy enclosed).

- 1. The CT/NY MOA (Paragraph 8) states (in part) that ... "any pilot who holds a license from both the State of Connecticut and the State of New York shall be allowed to maintain both licenses, but such pilot shall at the **commencement of this agreement** elect to work in the rotation under only one of his/her licenses. This pilot shall be subject to all of the pilotage rules and regulations of the state under which authority that pilot has elected to work."
- 2. Please be guided by the applicable CT/NY MOA terms and conditions which have continued in effect since the commencement of the agreement. The Board is not in a position to accept any changes to the original elections.
